Bierman v. Levenhagen, L.C.#2008FA1549

The court of appeals issued its decision in this matter on April 26, 2022. This court was informed that the parties did not receive notice of the decision until remittitur occurred on June 1, 2022. Because of the error in disseminating the decision to the parties, the pro se petition for review filed June 28, 2022 by petitioner-appellant-petitioner, Sophia Bierman, was untimely. Ms. Bierman filed a document on June 30, 2022, entitled "Motion for request to give permission to Supreme Court to file the Petition for Review and Appendix and other documents attached." This court construed that motion as a petition for supervisory writ which requested that the court accept the petition for review as timely filed. On July 27, 2022, this court issued an order granting the petition for supervisory writ, vacating the June 1, 2022 remittitur order, deeming the June 28, 2023 petition for review timely filed, and setting a deadline for a response to be filed.

On November 16, 2022, this court denied the June 28, 2023 petition for review. Also on November 16, 2022, since this court had issued its final decision, the court of appeals issued another remittitur order.

On June 28, 2023, Ms. Bierman, pro se, filed a motion in the court of appeals' incorrectly stating that the court of appeals did not comply with this court's July 27, 2022 order because it did

not vacate its April 26, 2022 decision. The court of appeals denied the motion on June 29, 2023, for lack of jurisdiction.

On July 7, 2023, Ms. Bierman, pro se, filed¹ a "Petition Request for Order", which seems to ask this court, amongst other things, to vacate the court of appeals' November 16, 2022 remittitur order due to its lack of compliance with this court's July 27, 2022 order. The court notes that its July 27, 2022 order did not vacate the court of appeals April 26, 2022 decision; it only vacated the June 1, 2022 remittitur order. This court deemed the petition for review filed on June 28, 2022, as timely filed. This court then declined to review the court of appeals' April 26, 2022 decision by denying the petition for review. Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action Ms. Bierman's July 7, 2023 filing.
