On May 26, 2023, this court issued an order construing petitioner Karl Julius James's April 11, 2023 filing to be a petition for writ of habeas corpus. The order also granted petitioner's motion for an extension of time to file the proper notarized indigency forms, and provided petitioner with a deadline to file by June 30, 2023. Prior to and since the court's May 26, 2023 order, petitioner has filed a number of motions for relief, including a motion that the clerk return all original copies of the filings in case no. 2023AP640-W. As neither the filing fee nor a petition for waiver of fees has been received by the court, the petition for writ of habeas corpus is subject to dismissal.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for writ of habeas corpus is dismissed. See Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83(2); and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall return petitioner's original filings in this case; and,
