Nos. 2021AP220 & 221 State v. Moore L.C.#s 2013CF4753 and 2014CF4475

The court having considered the motion of defendant-appellant-petitioner, Lamondre Moore, pro se, for an order directing Oshkosh Correctional Institution prison officials to pay the \$195.00 filing fee for Mr. Moore's petition for review from his prison release account, and the court noting that on July 14, 2023, Mr. Moore filed a Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency, but the form was not properly signed and notarized;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. Section 814.29(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes sets forth the procedure that anyone other than a "prisoner" as defined in Wis. Stat. § 801.02(7)(a)2 is required to follow in order to file a petition for review without prepaying the filing fee or giving security for costs. For purposes of this action, petitioner does not qualify as a "prisoner" under Wis. Stat. § 801.02(7)(a)2, and therefore Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1) applies. (A copy of Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1) is being attached to petitioner's copy of this order.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for review will be subject to dismissal under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83 unless, within 20 days of the date of this order, petitioner pays the \$195.00 filing fee or shows good cause for waiving the prepayment of the filing fee by filing a fully completed, signed, and notarized Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency, a copy of which is being sent to petitioner with his copy of this order. Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1)(b). If
