You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2022AP257-CR State v. Simmons, L.C.# 2018CF1029

The court having considered the motion of defendant-appellant-petitioner, Arthur G. Simmons, pro se, for an amended order that specifies that costs related to the preparing and filing of his supplemental petition for review can be paid only from his prison release trust account and not from his regular trust account;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The Stanley Correctional Institution (or the institution currently having custody of defendant-appellant-petitioner) shall provide access to funds to which defendant-appellant-petitioner is otherwise entitled, including his regular trust account and his release trust account as necessary, in order to pay for legal materials and copies for preparing and filing the defendant-appellant-petitioner's supplemental petition in support of the no-merit petition for review. The institution may determine the order in which the defendant-appellant-petitioner accesses his trust accounts. This order is confined to only the reasonably necessary expenses of preparing and filing the supplemental petition in this court. The defendant-appellant-petitioner is reminded that his supplemental petition in support of the no-merit petition for review shall be filed on or before October 13, 2023. The defendant-appellant-petitioner will

need to file only one copy of the supplemental petition. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.80(1) (2021-22). If the supplemental petition is not filed by October 13, 2023, this matter may be disposed of based solely on the documents filed in this matter to date.
