No. 2023AP769-CR State v. Thornton L.C. #2019CF397

On September 8, 2023, defendant-appellant, Ryan T. Thornton, pro se, filed a "Motion for Relief of Petition for Review Page/Word Count Limits and Filing of the Appendix." Thorton seeks permission to file an over-sized petition for review of "roughly 60 pages" arising from an August 22, 2023 order of the court of appeals that dismissed his appeal for lack of jurisdiction. Thorton also seeks leave to have this court accept a 1330-page appendix he filed in the court of appeals as his appendix to his anticipated petition for review, along with an additional document.

The court notes that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(2)(f), an appendix to a petition for review is to contain only: (1) "The decision and opinion of the court of appeals;" (2) "The judgments, orders, findings of fact, conclusions of law and memorandum decisions of the circuit court and administrative agencies necessary for an understanding of the petition;" (3) "Any other portions of the record necessary for an understanding of the petition;" and (4) "A copy of any unpublished opinion cited under s. 809.23 (3) (a) or (b)." (Emphasis added). The court also notes that the 1330-page appendix that Thorton references is already part of the appellate record in this case. Having considered the above information,

IT IS ORDERED the motion to file an over-sized petition for review and appendix is denied.
