On May 30, 2023, petitioner-petitioner, Salaam Johnson, pro se, filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus in the court of appeals. By order of August 2, 2023, the court of appeals dismissed Mr. Johnson's habeas petition for failure to pay the filing fee or show good cause for a fee waiver by the court-imposed deadline of July 26, 2023.

On August 18, 2023, Mr. Johnson filed what this court construed to be a petition to review the court of appeals' August 2, 2023 order. Also on August 18, 2023, the clerk's office issued an order, which erroneously appeared on the court of appeals' letterhead, informing Mr. Johnson that his petition would be dismissed if he did not pay the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for a fee waiver by filing a petition for waiver of fees within ten days of the order. On September 13, 2023, Mr. Johnson filed a petition for waiver of fees. Also on September 13, 2023, the clerk's office issued an order, which again erroneously appeared on the court of appeals' letterhead, stating that Mr. Johnson's petition for waiver of fees demonstrated indigency for the purpose of obtaining a fee waiver.

To avoid any confusion arising from the clerk of courts' use of incorrect letterhead on the August 18 and September 13, 2023 orders,

IT IS ORDERED that the August 18 and September 13, 2023 orders are hereby vacated;  
and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Johnson's petition for waiver of fees establishes indigency, and the court therefore grants Mr. Johnson permission to proceed with his petition for review in this court without payment of the filing fee. The petition for review shall be decided by the court in due course.
