The court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter on August 15, 2023, which it declined to reconsider by order of August 24, 2023. On September 25, 2023, defendant-appellant, Aman D. Singh, pro se, submitted via facsimile transmission a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' August 15, 2023 decision.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because a petition for review submitted by a paper filer must be physically<sup>1</sup> filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10, 809.62(1m), and 809.80; see also St. John's Home v. Continental Cas. Co., 150 Wis. 2d 37, 43, 441 N.W.2d 219 (1989). Further, a petition for review, including a nonconforming one, may not be filed via facsimile transmission.

<sup>1</sup> Since Mr. Singh is a self-represented party who has not registered as an electronic filer, his filings are governed by Wis. Stat. § 809.80 (2021-22). Therefore, Mr. Singh was required to physically file a paper copy of his petition for review.
