On June 29, 2023, this court construed a motion filed by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Lamondre Moore, pro se, as a timely but nonconforming petition for review and ordered him to file a statement in support of the petition by September 11, 2023.

By mailings that appear to have been placed in the prison mail system on or before this deadline, Mr. Moore filed a 98-page appendix to his statement in support of his petition for review (filed September 13, 2023), and a 30-page statement in support of his petition for review (filed September 20, 2023).

Apparently unsure of whether these documents had arrived at the clerk's office for filing, Mr. Moore filed two motions asking for relief. First, on September 28, 2023, Mr. Moore filed a motion asking for an order directing prison officials to make a copy of his appendix for filing. Second, on October 2, 2023, Mr. Moore filed a motion asking, among other things, for the court to grant him additional time to file his statement in support of his petition for review.
