On October 4, 2023, defendant-appellant, Chris Michael Shaughnessy filed a pro se motion entitled "Brief Explanation of Circumstances Defendant-Appellant Petitioner Feel[s] the Supreme Court Should Be Made Aware of in Determining Indigency." The motion indicates that Mr. Shaughnessy intends to pursue filing in this court a pro se petition for review of the court of appeals' September 19, 2023 decision in this case, that Mr. Shaughnessy seeks a waiver of the \$195.00 filing fee for petitions for review, and requests that the court waive the requirement of filing ten copies, and that he be required only to file one copy of the petition for review with the clerk of this court, and to serve one copy on the Attorney General. With the motion, Mr. Shaughnessy filed a completed Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency and a notarized Trust Account Activity Statement. In order to invoke the court's appellate jurisdiction in this matter, the court construes the motion to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. However, defendant-appellant must file a statement in support of the petition,

conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), with the clerk of this court by November 20, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall make a determination on defendant-appellant's pending petition for waiver of the filing fee by October 24, 2023; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for waiver of the required number of copies is dismissed as moot. Effective July 1, 2023, paper filers in the supreme court are required to submit a single copy of each filing to the clerk of this court. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.80(1). Consequently, defendant-appellant may file one copy of his statement in support of the petition for review on or before November 20, 2023. Defendant-appellant is reminded, however, that he remains solely responsible for serving one copy of his statement in support of the petition for review on the Attorney General, as the clerk of this court is neither required nor authorized to serve papers on behalf of litigants.
