Wilde v. Dept. of Public Instruction L.C.# 2022CV1209

On September 11, 2023, defendant-appellant, Jeffrey A. Wilde, filed a pro se petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of July 17, 2023, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated August 9, 2023. On September 20, 2023, this court issued an order dismissing Mr. Wilde's petition as untimely. On October 4, 2023, Mr. Wilde filed a letter that this court construes to be a motion for reconsideration of the court's September 20, 2023 order.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. As a self-represented party who has not registered as an electronic filer, Mr. Wilde's filings are governed by Wis. Stat. § 809.80 (2021-22). His petition for review needed to be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on the motion for reconsideration; i.e., by September 8, 2023. See Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10(2), 809.62(1m), 809.80, and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). The envelope that enclosed Mr. Wilde's petition for review shows that Mr. Wilde mailed it on the deadline date of September 8, 2023. "[T]he filing of a petition does not occur upon its mailing." Gunderson v. State, 106 Wis. 2d 611, 615, 318 N.W.2d 779(1982). Mr. Wilde's petition was received and filed by the clerk on September 11, 2023, beyond the 30-day deadline.
