On October 9, 2023, the court of appeals denied a supervisory writ petition filed by petitioner Bonnie M. Krause-Kapalczynski in the above-captioned matter. On October 18, 2023, Ms. Krause-Kapalczynski filed two documents: (1) a "Request for an Enlargement of Time to Prepare Petition For Review For Writ of Errors and Consolidations of Matters"; and (2) an "Emergency Application for Stay Pending for Writ of Certiorario, or in the Alternative, Mandamus and Prohibition of Sale of Marital Homestead and to Vacate the Divorce." The caption on both documents lists case number 2023AP1508. However, upon review, it appears that Ms. Krause-Kapalczynski intends to pursue relief in the above-captioned matter. Therefore, the court construes the "Request for an Enlargement of Time" to be a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' October 9, 2023 decision in the above-captioned matter.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for extension is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Any petition for review of the court of appeals' October 9, 2023 decision must be filed with this court within 30 days of the date of that

decision; i.e., by November 8, 2023. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10(1). The petition must conform to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other requests for relief are dismissed as premature given that Ms. Krause-Kapalczynski has yet to file a timely, rule-compliant petition for review.
