On April 10, 2020, the Petitioners, Wisconsin Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, et al., filed an "Emergency Petition and Memorandum to Supreme Court to Take Jurisdiction of an Original Action" pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.70, together with an Appendix.
