Wingra Redi-Mix Inc. v. LIRC, L.C.#2020CV1812

On July 7, 2023, plaintiff-appellant-petitioner, Wingra Redi-Mix, Inc., filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' June 8, 2023 decision. On September 15, 2023, the parties informed the court that they had reached a settlement, and they asked that this court hold the petition for review in abeyance for 30 days to allow them to execute a formal settlement agreement.

By order of September 19, 2023, this court held the petition for review in abeyance for a period of 30 days. The court also ordered plaintiff-appellant-petitioner to inform this court, in writing, by October 19, 2023, of the status of the formal settlement agreement and whether or not it continues to want its petition for review held in abeyance.

On October 18, 2023, plaintiff-appellant-petitioner informed the court that the parties have not finalized the formal settlement agreement, and it requests the court to hold its petition for review in abeyance for an additional 21 days. Accordingly;
