Petitioner v. Grinage, L.C.#2012CV260

By order of October 5, 2023, this court construed the October 2, 2023 document filed by the Petitioner as a nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' August 31, 2023 decision, which that court declined to reconsider on September 19, 2023. In that same October 5, 2023 order, we directed the Petitioner to file a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § § 809.62(2) and (4), by November 1, 2023. Also on October 5, 2023, this court issued an order informing the Petitioner that this matter would be subject to dismissal under Rule 809.83 unless, within ten days of the date of the order, the \$195.00 filing fee was received by the clerk of this court, or good cause was shown for waiving the fee by the filing of the petition for waiver of fees which was forwarded with that order.

On October 27, 2023, this court dismissed the petition for review because the Petitioner had failed to pay the required filing fee or submit a petition for waiver of fees. On October 31, 2023, the court received from the Petitioner a lengthy document titled "Affidavit."

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on Petitioner's October 31, 2023 filing because this matter has already been dismissed for failure to pay the filing fee, and, in any event, the filing does not conform to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § § 809.62(2) and (4), as required by the court's October 5, 2023 order.
