Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Erick R. Tyrone

On September 26, 2023, and October 10, 2023 (as amended October 13, 2023), this court issued orders holding this reciprocal discipline matter in abeyance based on representations from the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) that the parties were working on a stipulation. Pursuant to the October 10, 2023 order, the OLR has filed an additional status report dated November 9, 2023, which indicates that the parties have still not executed a stipulation and that the respondent, Attorney Erick R. Tyrone, has not responded to the OLR's most recent communication, and which asks this court to hold this matter in abeyance and not to appoint a referee for an additional 30 days. (The court again notes that a referee generally is not appointed in a reciprocal discipline matter under Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 22.22.) Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the matter is held in abeyance until December 11, 2023. No further periods of abeyance will be granted. If a stipulation is not filed by December 11, 2023, the court will issue an order to show cause pursuant to SCR 22.22(2) and (3).
