Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Vladimir M. Gorokhovsky

Pending before this court is Attorney Vladimir M. Gorokhovsky's appeal of the referee's report in an attorney disciplinary matter. On November 6, 2023, this court granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion for a 90-day stay of the appeal or, in alternative, for a 90-day extension of time to file his brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 3, 2024. This court's November 6, 2023 order further stated that additional extensions of time were unlikely to be granted absent an affidavit from a medical professional stating that Attorney Gorokhovsky does not have the capacity to perform the duties of his profession.

On December 29, 2023, Attorney Gorokhovsky filed a second motion for a temporary stay of the appeal or, in alternative, for a 90 to 120-day extension of time to file his opening brief. Attached to the motion is a sworn declaration of Corey Shamah, M.D. which states that while Attorney Gorokhovsky is experiencing physical limitations, he is "otherwise physically and mentally competent to perform" the duties of his profession. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion is granted, in part. The opening brief shall be filed on or before January 31, 2024. No further extensions of time will be granted.
