Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Vladimir M. Gorokhovskiy

Pending before this court is Attorney Vladimir M. Gorokhovskiy's appeal of the referee's report in an attorney disciplinary matter. On November 6, 2023, this court granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovskiy's motion for a 90-day stay of the appeal or, in alternative, for a 90-day extension of time to file his brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 3, 2024. On January 2, 2024, this court again granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovskiy's second motion for a temporary stay of the appeal or, in alternative, a 90- to 120-day extension of time to file his opening brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 31, 2024. This court's January 2, 2024 order further stated that no further extensions of time would be granted.

On January 23, 2024, Attorney Gorokhovskiy filed a motion to reconsider this court's January 2, 2024 order and grant a third, but final, extension of time to file his opening brief by April 16, 2024. Attorney Gorokhovskiy additionally requests that the page limit of the opening brief be increased and asks that Referee James Friedman provide a courtesy PDF copy of the referee report and recommendation. Attached to the motion is a sworn declaration of Corey Shamah, M.D., which states that Attorney Gorokhovskiy is "under significant physical and mental stress" from ongoing treatment, and that toxicities as a result of the ongoing treatment are "severely limiting his performance status and his ability to perform job related functions." Upon consideration of the motion and Dr. Shamah's declaration,

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion for reconsideration, or, in the alternative for a third and final extension of time to file his opening brief is granted. Attorney Gorokhovsky shall file his opening brief by April 16, 2024. No further extensions will be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for a page limit extension is denied. Attorney Gorokhovsky is referred to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.19(8)(c) which states that appellants' opening briefs shall not exceed 50 pages.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for Referee Friedman to provide a PDF copy of the referee report and recommendation is denied.
