By order of January 11, 2024, this court construed a letter filed on January 2, 2024, by defendant-appellant, Terrence T. Lafaive, pro se, as a motion for an extension of time to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of December 20, 2023. This court deemed the motion to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review, and ordered that Mr. Lafaive file a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), with the clerk of this court by February 16, 2024.

In a document dated January 12, 2024, and received by the clerk of this court on January 17, 2024, Mr. Lafaive asked this court "to consider his Petition for review filed, and grant [him] (60) sixty days to submit a statement in support of his petition." Because this filing appeared to have crossed in the mail with the court's January 11, 2024 order granting Mr. Lafaive until February 16, 2024 to file a statement in support of his petition, this court took no action on this filing.

On January 25, 2024, Mr. Lafaive filed a "Motion for Reconsideration" claiming that he never received a copy of this court's January 11, 2024 order and asking, among other things, "that the extension of time starts in accordance to the day he filed his motion to extend."

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted in part. Mr. Lafaive's statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), shall now be due on March 18, 2024. No further extensions will be granted. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition may be summarily dismissed. Mr. Lafaive is advised that his filing fees have been waived in this court for purposes of this matter; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other requests for relief in Mr. Lafaive's "Motion for Reconsideration" are denied; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall include with Mr. Lafaive's copy of this order a copy of this court's January 11, 2024 order.
