Siewert v. Decker, L.C.#2022CV143

On December 28, 2023, the court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.80 within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stats. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. In this case, because no motion for reconsideration was filed and because the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the court of appeals' final decision fell on a Saturday, the deadline for respondent-appellant-petitioner, Jeffrey S. Decker, to file a petition for review in this matter was Monday, January 29, 2024. See Wis. Stat. § 801.15. In addition, pursuant to Wis. Stat. (Rule) 809.62(2)(f), when a petition for review is filed, an appendix must also be filed "[a]s a separate document."

On January 29, 2024, Mr. Decker submitted multiple versions of a petition for review and appendix into the appellate eFiling system. All of the submitted versions contained the petition for review and appendix in a single document, contrary to Wis. Stat. (Rule) 809.62(2)(f).

On February 6, 2024, Mr. Decker submitted a motion to "supplement" and "revise" his petition for review. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that, in order to preserve this court's jurisdiction, the combined petitions for review and appendices submitted on January 29, 2024, are accepted as filed as of that date; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to supplement the petition for review is granted. On or before February 29, 2024, respondent-appellant-petitioner may file a supplemental petition for review and supplemental appendix as two separate documents with each conforming to the applicable rules set forth in Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any response to the supplemental petition for review shall be filed on or before March 14, 2024.
