No. 2022AP1495-CR State v. Bonilla, L.C.#2004CF5735

On January 19, 2024, defendant-appellant-petitioner, Jose M. Bonilla, filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' December 19, 2023 decision. Also on January 19, 2024, this court issued an order informing defendant-appellant-petitioner that the filing fee had not been received and that this action would be dismissed if the filing fee was not received within 10 days of the order (i.e., by February 2, 2024). On January 25, 2024, a response to the petition for review was filed by plaintiff-respondent, State of Wisconsin.

On February 13, 2024, this court dismissed the petition for review because neither the filing fee nor a completed fee waiver petition had been received. On that same date, defendant-appellant-petitioner filed a motion for reconsideration of the dismissal order and a petition for waiver of the filing fee.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is granted. The February 13, 2024 dismissal order is vacated; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the filing fee for the petition for review in this matter is waived. This order waives only the filing fee for the petition for review in this matter. It is not a determination of indigency for any other purpose; and
