Douglas v. Milwaukee Municipal Court, Branch 2

On January 3, 2018, petitioner, State of Wisconsin ex rel. Roderick D. Douglas, filed a petition for supervisory writ. On March 2, 2018, the court dismissed Mr. Douglas's petition for supervisory writ for failure to pay the filing fee or file a petition for waiver of fees that established good cause for waiving the filing fee. On March 22, 2018, Mr. Douglas filed a motion for this court to reconsider its March 2, 2018 order dismissing the petition for supervisory writ filed in this case. Although Mr. Douglas attached to his motion for reconsideration a motion to proceed in forma pauperis, he did not file the court's petition for waiver of fees form that was previously provided to him. Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that within ten days of the date of this order petitioner may file with the clerk of this court the petition for waiver of fees attached to this order. If petitioner's petition for

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waiver of fees is received timely, the court will determine whether petitioner's petition for supervisory writ may be reinstated without the prepayment of the filing fee.
