State v. Murray, L.C.#2015CF1197

On December 19, 2023, the court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter, and on January 9, 2024, it denied a timely motion for reconsideration filed by defendant-appellant, Huandra J. Murray, pro se. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10. Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter was **Thursday, February 8, 2024**. Id.

A petition for review signed by Mr. Murray was received in the clerk's office on February 14, 2024. The petition contained a "Certificate of Mailing," which certified that the petition for review had been placed into the prison mail system on **February 9, 2024**. On February 14, 2024, the court, through its clerk's office, dismissed the petition for review as untimely.

On March 4, 2024, Mr. Murray filed a letter that this court construes as a motion for reconsideration of the February 14, 2024 dismissal order. In his motion, Mr. Murray suggests the clerk's office calculated his 30-day deadline to file a petition for review from the date of the court of appeals' final decision rather than from the date of the court of appeals' decision on the motion for reconsideration. That is not the case, as explained above.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is denied. For Mr. Murray's petition for review to have been timely, he needed to place the petition for review into the prison mail system within 30 days after the court of appeals' decision on the motion for reconsideration. See State ex rel. Nichols v. Litscher, 2001 WI 119, 247 Wis. 2d 1013, 635 N.W.2d 292. Mr. Murray did so one day after this deadline. Consequently, the petition is untimely pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10 and 809.62(1m), and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d. 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979).
