In re the reinstatement of Brian K. Polk

On May 11, 2007, this court issued a per curiam opinion denying Attorney Brian K. Polk's petition for the reinstatement of his license to practice law in this state following an administrative suspension of three or more consecutive years due to his failure to comply with the mandatory reporting requirements for continuing legal education (CLE). As part of the court's mandate, it ordered Attorney Polk to pay the costs of the reinstatement proceeding, which were \$6,232.45 as of October 25, 2006. On July 13, 2007, Attorney Polk filed an affidavit in which he described his current financial condition and requested that he be allowed to pay \$10 per month toward the cost assessment.

IT IS ORDERED that the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) and Attorney Brian K. Polk shall discuss as soon as reasonably practical possible arrangements for a payment plan for the payment by Attorney Polk of the cost assessment, and shall advise the court, in writing, within 20 days of the date of this order whether they have reached an agreement on the payment of the cost assessment.
