Brian K. Polk v. Office of Lawyer Regulation

On July 24, 2007, and August 28, 2007, this court issued orders directing Attorney Brian K. Polk and the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) to discuss Attorney Polk's request for a payment plan for the cost assessment imposed in the court's May 11, 2007 *per curiam* opinion and to advise the court of the status of their discussions. If the parties were unable to reach a mutually agreeable resolution, the OLR was ordered to file a response to Attorney Polk's July 13, 2007 affidavit and motion. On September 10, 2007, the OLR filed a letter indicating that the parties had not reached a resolution, that it believed that the requested payment amount of \$10 per month was insufficient, and that Attorney Polk had failed to complete a requested financial disclosure statement.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for a reduced payment plan is held in abeyance until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before October 31, 2007, Attorney Brian K. Polk shall complete and return to the OLR the financial disclosure statement on the form provided to him by the OLR.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the OLR and Attorney Brian K. Polk shall each separately advise the court, in writing, on or before November 30, 2007, whether they have reached an agreement on the payment of the cost assessment, and, if they have not reached an agreement, on their respective positions as to the appropriate amount for a payment plan, with supporting arguments.
