You are hereby notified that the Court has entered the following order:

No. 2006AP3096-D Brian K. Polk v. Office of Lawyer Regulation

The court having considered the motion and affidavit of Attorney Brian K. Polk for the establishment of a monthly payment plan for the satisfaction of the cost assessment imposed in the court's May 11, 2007 per curiam opinion, as well as the responses by Attorney Polk and the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) to the court's orders of August 28, 2007, and October 10, 2007;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for the establishment of a monthly payment plan is granted in part. Beginning on February 1, 2008, Attorney Brian K. Polk shall make monthly payments to the OLR in the amount of \$20.00 per month toward the outstanding cost assessment until the cost assessment is fully paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before January 18, 2008, Attorney Brian K. Polk shall provide to the OLR copies of a current pay stub and his federal and state income tax returns for 2006.

Brian K. Polk v. Office of Lawyer Regulation

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or about July 1, 2008, and at six-month intervals thereafter, the OLR and Attorney Brian K. Polk shall review Attorney Polk's financial status and determine whether the payment amount should be adjusted. At least two weeks prior to such financial reviews, Attorney Polk shall furnish the OLR with an updated financial disclosure statement on a form provided by the OLR and with copies of Attorney Polk's latest federal and state income tax returns. If a party believes that the amount of the monthly payment should be adjusted, the party shall file a motion seeking an adjustment in the payment amount.
