On March 20, 2018, the court dismissed the petition for writ of habeas corpus filed by petitioner, John Joseph Munoz, Jr., for failure to pay the required filing fee or file a petition for waiver of fees that established good cause for waiving the filing fee. IT IS ORDERED that the March 20, 2018 order is vacated, and the petition for writ of habeas corpus is reinstated; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in a separate order, this court will determine whether petitioner is entitled to file his petition for writ of habeas corpus without the prepayment of the filing fee. Petitioner is advised that if the court determines that he has assets in trust fund accounts, whether accessible to the prisoner only upon release or before release, the court will require that those funds be used to make an initial payment, in whole or in part, of the filing fee.
