Stingley v. Laczkowski, L.C.#2017CV2791

On April 3, 2024, plaintiff-appellant-petitioner, Craig LaFayette Stingley, pro se, filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' March 5, 2024 decision. On that same date, Mr. Stingley filed a "Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs – Affidavit of Indigency." On April 4, 2024, the court issued an order stating that the petition for waiver of fees filed did not establish that Mr. Stingley could not maintain the costs of prosecuting this action. The court ordered Mr. Stingley to pay the filing fee within five days of the order. Also on April 4, 2024, Mr. Stingley filed a motion for reconsideration of the fee waiver order. The court notes that Mr. Stingley provided different information in his motion for reconsideration than in his original fee waiver petition, filed just one day before. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is held in abeyance pending further order of this court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by April 10, 2024, Mr. Stingley shall file a credible fee waiver petition that accurately represents all household income, assets, and expenses other than ordinary living expenses. The court notes that "storage costs" are not considered other than

ordinary living expenses. The filing of the fee waiver petition does not guarantee that the filing fee will be waived. However, failure to file a credible and accurate petition for fee waiver will result in Mr. Stingley having to pay the required \$195.00 petition for review filing fee.
