On March 5, 2024, the court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10. Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter was Thursday, April 4, 2024. Id.

On April 5, 2024, the court received multiple notices of appeal in an envelope that indicates it was mailed on April 2, 2024, from defendant-appellant, Eliseo Calderon-Torres, pro se. The notices of appeal all state that Mr. Calderon-Torres is seeking review of the final order or judgement entered on March 5, 2024. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the notices of appeals received on April 5, 2024, shall be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals March 5, 2024 final decision. See State ex rel. Nichols v. Litscher, 2001 WI 119, 247 Wis. 2d 1013, 635 N.W.2d 292.
