Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Vladimir M. Gorokhovskiy

Pending before this court is Attorney Vladimir M. Gorokhovskiy's appeal of the referee's report in an attorney disciplinary matter. On November 6, 2023, this court granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovskiy's motion for a 90-day stay of the appeal or, in alternative, for a 90-day extension of time to file his brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 3, 2024. On January 2, 2024, this court again granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovskiy's second motion for a temporary stay of the appeal or, in alternative, a 90- to 120-day extension of time to file his opening brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 31, 2024. On January 24, 2024, this court again granted Attorney Gorokhovskiy's third and final motion for an extension of time to file his opening brief to April 16, 2024. This court's January 24, 2024 order further stated that no further extensions of time would be granted.

On April 16, 2024, Attorney Gorokhovskiy filed a motion to convert the matter to e-filing and for waiver of the paper brief requirement or, in alternative, for an additional six business days to file paper versions of his brief. Upon consideration of the motion,

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovskiy's motion to convert the matter to e-filing is denied. See S. Ct. Order 23-03, 2023 WI 47 (issued June 12, 2023, eff. July 1, 2023) ("any party

to a judicial/attorney proceeding in the Wisconsin Supreme Court . . . shall be considered to be a 'paper party' . . . and shall sign, file, and serve documents by 'traditional methods.'")

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovskiy's motion for an extension to file paper copies with this court is granted. Attorney Gorokhovskiy must file paper copies of his brief with this court by April 25, 2024. No further extensions will be granted.
