Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Vladimir M. Gorokhovsky

Pending before this court is Attorney Vladimir M. Gorokhovsky's appeal of the referee's report in an attorney disciplinary matter. On November 6, 2023, this court granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion for a 90-day stay of the appeal or, in alternative, for a 90-day extension of time to file his brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 3, 2024. On January 2, 2024, this court again granted, in part, Attorney Gorokhovsky's second motion for a temporary stay of the appeal or, in alternative, a 90- to 120-day extension of time to file his opening brief and ordered that the opening brief be filed by January 31, 2024. On January 24, 2024, this court again granted Attorney Gorokhovsky's third and final motion for an extension of time to file his opening brief to April 16, 2024. On April 17, 2024, this court again granted Attorney Gorokhovky's motion for an extension of time of six business days, or to April 25, 2024, to file paper versions of his brief in this court. This court's April 17, 2024 order further stated that no further extensions of time would be granted.

On April 22, 2024, Attorney Gorokhovsky filed a motion for leave to reduce the number of briefs that are required to be filed from 21 copies to 15 copies, for use of coal spiral binding for the briefs and appendices, and for an extension of time to allow for mailing of the briefs and appendices. Upon consideration of the motion,

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion for leave to reduce the number of briefs to be filed from 21 copies to 15 copies is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion to use coal spiral binding for the briefs and appendices is denied. Attorney Gorokhovsky is advised that the brief and appendix may be filed as separate documents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Attorney Gorokhovsky's motion for an extension of time for mailing of paper copies with this court is granted. Attorney Gorokhovsky must file 15 paper copies of his brief with this court by May 6, 2024.
