On March 26, 2024, the court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10. Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter was Thursday, April 25, 2024. See id.

On May 3, 2024, defendant-appellant, Robert Joseph Skenandore, pro se, filed a letter in this court requesting an enlargement of time to file a petition for review of the March 26, 2024 court of appeals' decision. The court construes this letter as a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely

but nonconforming petition for review because it was not filed within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stats. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Accordingly, this court has no jurisdiction in this matter. See Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360.
