Stingley v. Laczkowski, L.C.#2017CV2791

On April 12, 2024, this court ordered plaintiff-appellant-petitioner, Craig LaFayette Stingley, to pay the \$195.00 filing fee within 14 days (April 26, 2024) of the order or this action would be dismissed. By order of May 10, 2024, the court dismissed this action because the filing fee had not been received. Also by order of May 10, 2024, the court remitted this matter to the circuit court. On May 14, 2024, Mr. Stingley filed a motion for reconsideration of the May 10, 2024 dismissal order. In his motion, Mr. Stingley alleges that he paid the filing fee on April 25, 2024, and he attached to his motion a copy of the electronic receipt. After a review of the record, it appears that Mr. Stingley failed to provide identifying information with his electronic payment, however, based on the electronic receipt provided with his motion, the court was able to confirm that he paid the filing fee before the April 26, 2024 deadline.
