On April 30, 2024, the court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter, and on May 20, 2024, it denied a timely motion for reconsideration filed by plaintiff-appellant-petitioner, Pat Schottler, pro se. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10. Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter is Wednesday, June 19, 2024. See id.

On May 14, 2024, plaintiff-appellant-petitioner filed three documents in this court. The documents include: (1) a "Notice of appeal"; (2) a "Motion [t]o be put on the state Supreme court Bar . . . for the purpose of litigating this case"; and (3) a "Motion / seeking order [sic] the clerk of court is [sic] to assign dates to chose [sic] from for [sic] use of the Supreme court hearing room. . . ." (Ellipses in original.)

On May 22, 2024, plaintiff-appellant-petitioner filed a document entitled "Appellants Brief."
