You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2020AP1651-D Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Madaleine R. Mulrey

On March 20, 2024, this court privately reprimanded Attorney Madaleine R. Mulrey for professional misconduct. The court's order required Ms. Mulrey to pay to the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) the costs of the proceeding, which are \$19,706.46, within 60 days of the date of the order.

On May 23, 2024, Ms. Mulrey filed a motion to extend the deadline to pay from 60 days to 180 days. The motion states that Ms. Mulrey would like to work out an agreement with the OLR by which the cost assessment may be paid over time. On June 3, 2024, OLR filed a response to the motion, stating that while it is concerned that there would be no payment plan that would likely satisfy both parties, the OLR is willing to consider a proposal for such. The OLR stated it provided Ms. Mulrey with a personal financial disclosure form to begin the process of discussing a payment plan.

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Madaleine R. Mulrey's motion for an extension of time to pay the costs associated with this matter, as ordered in this court's March 20, 2024 order, is granted. Ms. Mulrey shall have until September 16, 2024 to either provide this court with proof of payment
