No. 2023AP189-CR State v. Plunkett, L.C.#2019CF282

On May 6, 2024, Attorney David R. Karpe filed a petition for review in this matter on behalf of defendant-appellant-petitioner, Juan L. Plunkett. On May 16, 2024, plaintiff-respondent, State of Wisconsin, filed a response to the petition for review.

On June 28, 2024, Attorney Karpe filed a motion to withdraw as counsel on grounds that he was closing his practice and deactivating his law license. The motion does not indicate that it was served on Mr. Plunkett, contrary to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.30(4)(a). On July 1, 2024, the Regional Attorney Manager for the Madison Appellate division of the Wisconsin State Public Defender's office, Kelsey Loshaw, filed a letter with this court stating that if the court grants Attorney Karpe's motion, the State Public Defender will appoint successor counsel.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to withdraw as counsel is held in abeyance pending Attorney Karpe's filing of proof of service of his motion on Mr. Plunkett.
