On July 11, 2024, defendant-appellant, Kimeo D. Conley, pro se, filed a motion asking this court to "take (Jurisdiction) over this case for review," or "(Appoint Counsel) to file the proper paper work," or "deny the motions and order that the remmittur [sic] be sent back to the (circuit court)." The court construes this motion to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review and a motion to appoint counsel. Defendant-appellant is advised that this court will not take jurisdiction over this case on its own motion. It will consider a proper petition for review. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. A statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by August 21, 2024. If the defendant-appellant advised the court that he does not wish to submit a statement in support of the petition or if the statement in support is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to appoint counsel is denied. There is no constitutional right to appointed counsel on a petition for review from a court of appeals' decision affirming a circuit court order denying a motion for sentence modification.
