No. 2015AP680-D      OLR v. Amoun Vang Sayaovong

Attorney Amoun Vang Sayaovong has appealed a referee's report recommending that this court deny Attorney Sayaovong's petition for the reinstatement of his license to practice law in Wisconsin. Attorney Sayaovong did not request oral argument in either his opening brief or his reply brief, nor did the Office of Lawyer Regulation request oral argument. Accordingly, Attorney Sayaovong's appeal is on the court's December 2024 argument calendar as an on briefs case. On November 4, 2024, Attorney Sayaovong filed a motion requesting oral argument.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. Supreme Court Rule 22.23(2) provides that an appeal from the report of the referee is conducted under the rules governing civil appeals to the supreme court. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.19(1)(c) provides that the appellant's opening brief must contain, inter alia, "A statement with reasons as to whether oral argument is necessary..." Attorney Sayaovong's request for oral argument is untimely.
