On July 11, 2012, petitioner, Lorenzo D. Kyles, filed a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' order of May 9, 2012, and to appoint counsel. Mr. Kyles had timely moved the court of appeals for reconsideration of its May 9, 2012 order. The court of appeals denied this motion on June 14, 2012;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to extend the time to file a petition for review is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by September 12, 2012. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to appoint counsel is held in abeyance during the pendency of the petition for review.
