Huiras v. Cafferty, L.C. #2023CV499

On August 1, 2024, a petition to bypass the court of appeals was filed by petitioner-appellant, Nathan Huiras, pro se. The court notes that “[a] party may file with the supreme court a petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to s. 808.05 no later than 14 days following the filing of the respondent’s brief under s. 809.19 or response.” Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60(1). There are two respondents in this matter; one filed a response on November 2, 2023, and the other filed a response on November 6, 2023, making any bypass due, at the latest, by November 20, 2023. Because Mr. Huiras filed his petition to bypass over eight months after this due date,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition to bypass is dismissed as untimely.
