You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2024AP2301-W Wendling v. Gibbs, L.C. #2018FA264

On January 8, 2025, this court received an electronically filed single cover page of a petition for review filed by petitioner Angela M. Wendling, pro se. On January 9, 2025, this court received ten paper copies of a complete petition for review filed by Ms. Wendling. Ms. Wendling has opted in as a voluntary electronic filing party in this case and remains in that status. Ms. Wendling has not utilized the "opt out" feature of the electronic filing system or given notice to the clerk of court as is required by Wis. Stat. § 809.801(3)(i). Although Ms. Wendling is therefore currently required to file all documents electronically, this court will, on a one-time basis, accept for filing the paper petition for review. The court places Ms. Wendling on notice, however, that, unless she opts out of the electronic filing system, the court will not accept paper copies of any future filing.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for review in this matter is accepted for filing as of January 9, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for all future filings in this case, Ms. Wendling shall adhere to electronic filing requirements as set forth in Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.801, unless she has completed the procedure referenced above to opt out of electronic filing, in which case she will be

required to file and serve all documents via traditional (paper) methods. Future documents that are not filed in the manner that Ms. Wendling has designated will not be accepted for filing.
