Defendant-appellant-petitioner, Daniel J. Fouliard, pro se, filed a petition for review with this court on October 30, 2024. On November 8, 2024, this court granted Fouliard's motion to extend the time to file an amended petition for review until November 22, 2024. Thereafter, Fouliard moved to extend time to file his amended petition of review until February 1, 2025. On November 25, 2024, this court granted the motion, in part, and extended the time for Fouliard to file an amended petition for review until January 6, 2025. On January 3, 2025, Fouliard filed a motion to extend the time to file an amended petition for review until January 10, 2025, citing his difficulty using the e-filing system. However, on January 6, 2025, Fouliard submitted an amended petition for review, which was accepted for filing the same date. Thus, on January 8, 2025, this court entered an order denying Fouliard's January 3rd motion as moot.

On January 13, 2025, Fouliard filed another motion to extend the time to file an amended petition for review, requesting an additional week, indicating that he desired to make additional arguments. Because the court had already granted Fouliard multiple extensions and Fouliard had, in fact, filed an amended petition within the January 6, 2025 deadline, this court denied Fouliard's January 13, 2025 motion for an extension to file another amended petition for review. January 13, 2025 order further indicated that “[n]o further motions or extensions relating to the amended petition for review will be entertained.”

Nonetheless, on January 17, 2025, Fouliard submitted yet another amended petition for review. That submission was erroneously accepted for filing by the clerk.

In the interim, plaintiff-respondent, the State of Wisconsin, filed a motion to seal Fouliard’s filings, as they contained confidential medical information concerning the victim in this case. This court granted the motion to seal on January 14, 2025. The State has now filed a similar motion to seal related to Fouliard’s erroneously accepted January 17, 2025 filing, indicating that this document contains the same type of confidential medical information as his previous filings.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that amended petition for review submitted by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Daniel J. Fouliard on January 17, 2025 is not accepted for filing. The court will decide this matter based on the filing accepted on January 6, 2025;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff-respondent, the State of Wisconsin’s January 21, 2025 motion to seal defendant-appellant-petitioner, Daniel J. Fouliard’s January 17, 2025 submission is granted; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court is directed to reject any future filings of defendant-appellant-petitioner, Daniel J. Fouliard, that attempt to amend, modify, supplement, alter, replace, or add additional arguments to the amended petition for review that was accepted for filing on January 6, 2025.
