On January 27, 2025, this court received a “Motion to be Released on Bond seeking Post-conviction Relief Pursuant to Wis. Stat. Rule.809.31 (1), Wis. Stat. 969.01 (2)(d)” filed by Ambrose McDaniel, pro se. The court notes that Mr. McDaniel previously filed premature pro se motions, which this court dismissed by orders dated May 6, 2022, and October 5, 2022, and a pro se letter on which this court took no action on November 11, 2022. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the motion filed on January 27, 2025. This court’s appellate jurisdiction is invoked by a properly filed petition for review following a final decision issued by the court of appeals in an appeal. There is still no matter pending before this court involving Mr. McDaniel in which this court’s jurisdiction has been properly invoked. Mr. McDaniel’s current motion references State v. McDaniel, Milwaukee County Case No. 2022CF226. According to the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) website, Mr. McDaniel has filed a notice of intent to pursue postconviction relief and five subsequent motions to extend the time for filing a postconviction motion or notice of appeal.
