Brown v. Petty, L.C.#2017FA1347

On February 19, 2025, respondent-appellant, Godella Petty, pro se, filed the following documents: "Emergency Petition to the United States Supreme Court Request for Relief from Judicial Misconduct and Fraud," "Petition for Change of Venue Due to Judicial Misconduct, Corruption, and Denial of Due Process in Case FA 1347 2017," "Supplemental Motion for Emergency Investigation into Judicial and Attorney Misconduct, Vacatur of Fraudulent Judgment, and Criminal Accountability for Court Fraud," "Supplemental Motion for Immediate Relief, Federal Review, and Emergency Hearing Request," "Petition for Emergency Ex Parte Hearing, Change of Venue to Illinois, Admission of New Evidence, and Review of Judicial Misconduct in Case FA 1347 2017," and "Motion for Waiver of Filing Fees Due to Financial Hardship." These filings appear to concern a 2018 judgment of divorce entered by the Milwaukee County Circuit Court. In September 2022, the court of appeals summarily affirmed a circuit court order denying Ms. Petty's motion for reconsideration of the divorce judgment. See Brown v. Petty, 2021AP580, unpublished slip op. (Wis. Ct. App. Sept. 27, 2022);

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the motions filed on February 19, 2025. There is no proceeding pending in this court and no basis upon which this court could exercise its jurisdiction.
