- Respondent must appear for deposition. The fact that respondent might claim 5th
 Amendment privileges in response to some questions does not justify not appearing for deposition.
 Claiming 5th Amendment rights is done on a per question basis.
- 2. The respondent is being given one more opportunity to appear for deposition. If respondent does not appear, respondent will be sanctioned appropriately.
- 3. Respondent shall provide to complainant, by April 1, 2025, three two-day periods that the respondent is available for deposition. The deposition in this matter must be completed prior to April 15, 2025, unless both parties agree otherwise.
