Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Pappas, Jr.

On January 16, 2025, the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) filed a motion asking this court to issue an order granting the OLR permission to use the procedure set forth in Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 22.13(1) to effectuate service of notice to Attorney George S. Pappas, Jr. that his license to practice law in Wisconsin will be automatically suspended pursuant to SCR 22.03(4)(a) unless he timely complies with SCR 22.03(4)(a)1., 2., or 3.

The affidavit in support of the OLR's motion references a process server's unsuccessful December 2024 efforts to effect service on Attorney Pappas, and additionally references an affidavit from the process server detailing these efforts. However, the process server's affidavit attached to the OLR's filing concerns the server's previous unsuccessful efforts to serve Attorney Pappas in October 2024—efforts that formed the basis of a previous order from this court. See Unpublished S. Ct. Order, Case No. 2024XX1914-D (Dec. 10, 2024).

IT IS ORDERED that, within 10 calendar days of the date of this order, the OLR shall supplement its January 16, 2025 filing with the appropriate affidavit from the process server.
