No. 2021AP1992-CRNM State v. Sutton, L.C.#2019CF1

By order of May 13, 2024, this court construed a pro se motion filed by defendant-appellant Donsha Deshon Sutton to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' April 3, 2024 decision. The court required Mr. Sutton to file a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of §§ 809.62(2) and (4), with the clerk of this court by August 12, 2024. By orders of July 11, 2024, November 6, 2024, and January 31, 2025, this court granted Mr. Sutton's subsequent requests to extend this deadline. In its January 31, 2025 order, the court set a March 25, 2025 deadline and warned that "[n]o further extensions shall be granted."

On March 21, 2025, Mr. Sutton filed another motion for extension of time to file his statement in support of his petition for review, this time asking for the deadline to be reset to April 25, 2025. Noting that this matter has been pending in this court for over ten months,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted in part. Mr. Sutton's statement in support shall be served on parties and filed with the court on or before April 11, 2025. This is the final extension the court will allow. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed.
