On February 27, 2025, the court of appeals issued a decision in <u>Joseph v. Zuehlke</u>, No. 2023AP2162, summarily affirming the circuit court's decision dismissing Mr. Joseph's claims against Waushara County and various county officials. On March 18, 2025, Mr. Joseph filed a "Demand for a Redress of Grievance" in this court relating to the same subject matter as the aforementioned case. By order dated March 20, 2025, this court construed Mr. Joseph's document as a timely, but nonconforming, petition for review pursuant to Wis. STAT. § 809.62, and directed Mr. Joseph to submit a conforming statement in support of the petition by April 3, 2025.

On March 31, 2025, Mr. Joseph filed a document entitled "Demand for Correction," in which he explains that he did not intend his March 18, 2025 filing to be a petition for review, but instead a separate action "against the same parties." Based on the contents of Mr. Joseph's most recent filing, the court now construes the March 18, 2025 filing as a petition for leave to commence an original action under WIS. STAT. § 809.70. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the clerk of this court is directed to vacate the March 18, 2025 entry identifying Mr. Joseph's filing on that date as a petition for review in Case No. 2023AP2162; and
