No. 2025AP105                    Zloza v. Balberts or Alberts, L.C. #2024CV243

By order of April 2, 2025, this court addressed a one-paragraph document filed by pro se appellant, Joseph Zloza. The document stated, in part, “[m]otion to move to supreme court of Wisconsin, its not frivolous.” The court construed the filing as a petition to bypass the court of appeals. The court dismissed Mr. Zloza’s request, noting that he had not yet filed his appellate brief-in-chief. See Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Club v. Wisconsin Dept. of Health and Social Servs., 130 Wis. 2d 56, 62-63, 387 N.W.2d 245 (1986) (noting dismissal of initial petition to bypass as premature because briefs on appeal had not been filed).

On April 16, 2025, Mr. Zloza filed another document in this court titled “[m]otion to move to supreme court.” The substance of the document consists only of the following sentence: “The court of appeals is mishandling my brief, it was 809.19(1) format.”

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed for the same reason stated in our April 2, 2025 order. We note that, per the court of appeals’ April 9, 2025 order, Mr. Zloza’s appellate brief-in-chief is due May 7, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that additional motions of this nature directed to this court may be placed in the file without response.
