A petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 808.10 having been filed on behalf of Erin Scott, pro se, and considered by the court;

IT IS ORDERED the petition for review is dismissed. The subject of a petition for review must be the final decision of the court of appeals, not a decision or order of a circuit court. In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978). Consequently, to the extent that the petition seeks direct review of circuit court orders, the petition for review would be improper. In addition, a petition for review must be filed within 30 days of the date of the final decision of the court of appeals. Wis. Stat. § 808.10. To the extent that the petition could be interpreted as seeking review of the court of appeals' final decision or order in Nos. 2024AP2488, 2024AP2436-W, 2024AP2390-W, 2024AP2330, or 2023AP860, the final decision or order of the court of appeals in those matters occurred more than 30 days prior to the filing of the petition for review on April 14, 2025, so the petition for review would be untimely.
