On February 14, 2025, this court denied Marvin E. Williams' pro se motion to appoint counsel and to receive transcripts. Since then, Mr. Williams has filed several documents with this court, with attachments (some voluminous), requesting the same relief, including letters filed April 16, 17, and 18, 2025, and a document captioned "Habias Corpus Writ," which also requests the court appoint Mr. Williams a lawyer and order that certain transcripts be provided. The court construes these documents as motions for reconsideration of this court's February 14, 2024 order. Having considered the documents and attachments,

IT IS ORDERED that the motions for reconsideration are denied;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Williams is warned that continuing to file successive and duplicative requests for the same relief, however captioned, may result in the imposition of filing restrictions. See Minniecheske v. Griesbach, 161 Wis. 2d 743, 748, 468 N.W.2d 760 (Ct. App. 1991) ("A court faced with a litigant engaged in a pattern of frivolous litigation has the authority to implement a remedy that may include restrictions on that litigant's access to the court."); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that future filings from Mr. Williams directed to this court requesting the same relief may be placed in the file without response.
